## DSTA SCHOLARSHIPS

### **ALL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS AND TRANSCRIPTS MUST BE SENT THROUGH THE MAIL**

#### **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Scholarships shall be available to any full time student with a GPA of 2.5 who is attending an accredited college, university, or trade school who is a child or dependent of a Desert Sands Teachers Association member. Full time standing requires enrollment in 12 or more units.
2. Scholarships are also available to high school seniors planning on attending an accredited college, university, or trade school in the fall.
3. High school applicants must maintain a 3.0 grade point average during their junior and senior years. GPA must be calculated on two junior semesters and the fall senior semester.
4. Vocational education students must be in good standing at the high school level all four years.
5. Each year that the scholarship is being considered for renewal, applicant must supply DSTA with an updated copy of **TRANSCRIPT**, including GPA calculation and a new scholarship application. **Previous semester report cards will not be accepted.**
6. College applicants may apply for a scholarship if their application is filed **within four years of graduating** from high school.
7. Students **graduating from high school prior to 2003 are not eligible** for the \$200 scholarship. Students graduating in 2002 are eligible for the \$300 scholarship if they are pursuing their teaching credential at a fifth year level.

#### **SCHOLARSHIP DEFINITION:**

1. This scholarship shall be \$200 per year and is renewable for a total of \$800 during the four years directly following high school graduation. (Two years for Vocational students.)
2. This scholarship shall be \$300 for the fifth year teaching credential, providing it is the fifth year following the student's high school graduation.
